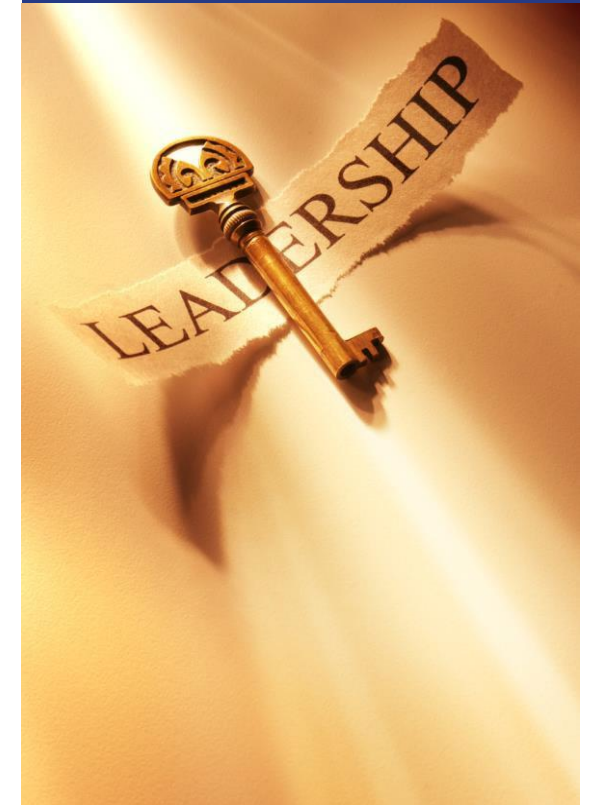

The Zion-Benton Leadership Academy was developed to nurture a new generation of leaders for our community. Its aim is to identify, assist and empower individuals to become active and inspiring contributors in our community.

The six-session curriculum features distinguished community leaders and training experts sharing their ideas, perspectives and experiences. The courses will concentrate on development of personal, ethical, leadership and managerial skills and provide grounding in the history and culture of the Zion-Benton community.

What does it take to be a Zion-Benton Leadership Academy participant?

The ideal leader is engaged, open-minded, compassionate, imaginative, honest and progressive. ZBLA is seeking candidates with some or all of those attributes. As a ZBLA participant, you can learn what it takes to be a leader who will help change the future of the

Zion-Benton community. You will be carefully matched to individual mentors with similar interests and backgrounds. Past mentors include school superintendents, pastors, business owners, organization leaders and interested citizens.

What is the time commitment?

- Participate in an interview in May.
- Attend bi-weekly ZBLA group sessions, from September through November.
- Meet regularly with ZBLA mentor, typically bi-weekly, during duration of the academy.
- Attend the ZBLA graduation in November.
- 2nd year self-paced leadership training.
